## Towing System Step 1

- Hitched securely?
- Weight distribution/ sway system set?
- All pins in place?
- Wiring harness plugged & Lights working
- Brake control set (if you are so equipped)

## Storage Step 3

- Loose Items Stored/Secured
- Cabinets latched/secured
- Roof Vent & windows closed
- Taps off/Shower Door latched
- Table Secured

*\*\*As travel trailers and RVs may have unique components, this checklist is meant for general guidance only and is not inclusive. Always ensure you are following manufacturers directions to ensure you have followed all steps before travel.*

## Exterior Step 2

- Tire pressure/wear check
- Retract tongue/stabilizing Jacks all the way
- Close and lock outdoor storage
- Check battery connection
- Check propane - on and set to one tank only if using

## Systems Step 4

- Lights Off
- Pump/Water heater off
- HVAC system off
- Pilot light off (oven)
- Fridge cooled & ready for travel \*

*\*always follow manufacturers instructions/local regulations on traveling with propane*
