





The oldest news we have of the fair of Morón dates back to the thirteenth century, existing in the Cabildo a parchment, signed by Alfonso X, authorizing this town to hold a fair (market).

A spectacular view standing out the Cathedral. It's a **Renaissance masterpiece** and the biggest one of this style. **The relic of "Holy Face"** is kept inside.



The Mosque-Cathedral of Cordoba is the most important monument of all the Western Islamic world, and one of the most amazing in the world.



The Alhambra is the jewel in the crown, the best- preserved & oldest Moorish palace, the most visited monument of ${\bf Granada}.$



Founded 3,000 years ago by the Phoenicians, C'adiz is the oldest city in Western Europe




Monastery of la Rábida. HUELVA

Fifteenth-century Franciscan convent. Regarded as the greatest symbol of the Discovery. The walls received a <u>Columbus</u> discouraged by the obstacles prior to his appointment as head of the real journey to the Indies.



The Torre del Oro of **Seville** is a remnant of the Mooris walls located on the left bank of the Guadalquivir River.
