Scottish Cycling | The Way Forward Guidance for Covid-19 Coordinators

All clubs wishing to return to organised activity under the Scottish Cycling Guidance should appoint a Covid-19 Coordinator to be the identified contact with Scottish Cycling to receive information in relation to the impact of Covid-19 on clubs, and lead on the implementation of new measures as they are introduced.

This role must be in close contact with the Club Committee and where applicable, the Club Coaching/ Leadership team. The role can be added to the remit of an existing committee member (such as the Wellbeing and Protection Officer) or co-opted onto the committee temporarily for the duration that the role is required.

Nominated Covid Coordinators are required to complete the Covid Officer E-Learning Module, <u>available here</u>. This module is compulsory for all Covid Coordinators in order to support the understanding of the role and measures which need to be implemented.
