- The City's Nuisance Bylaw is in place to prevent, abate, and prohibit nuisances and to prohibit persons from causing or permitting unsightliness on property within the City.
- The accumulation or excess growth of grasses, bushes, trees, noxious weeds, or other plants is considered unsightly under the City's Nuisance Bylaw.
- In June, there will be an increased awareness placed on educating property owners about unsightly properties and Bylaw Enforcement will be working proactively with properties which are not in compliance.
